Dear Parents and Carers,

As I am sure you are all now aware from yesterday's Government announcement, primary schools located in high transmission areas are to remain closed to the majority of children until at least 18th January 2021. Hayes Primary School is one of these schools so will only be open to vulnerable children and children of Key Workers from Monday 4th January 2021.

Category: Vulnerable children and children of Key Workers

Where a Key Worker parent or carer notifies us that their child requires full-time on-site provision, the school will make this available. Please see the below form for Key Workers to complete and return urgently. This must be completed and returned by 6pm on Friday 1st January 2021. Vulnerable children are expected to attend full-time on-site provision and we will write to you individually regarding this.

Please note, however, that COVID infection rates in Bromley are currently extremely high and it is safer for children to stay at home wherever possible. **In two parent households where only one parent is a Key Worker, we ask that children are kept at home as this will help to reduce the infection rate more quickly.**

Please note that in these initial two weeks, we will not be able to provide Breakfast or After School Club.

All other children who do not fall into the above mentioned categories

All other children who do not fall into the above categories will be learning from home. The Government's expectation is for Hayes Primary School to provide remote on-line education which we will provide via Google Classroom. Further correspondence regarding remote on-line learning will be sent in due course.

We hope all children will return to school on Monday 18th January 2021. However, as always, this will be subject to Government decisions.

We will continue to keep you informed and post updates on our school website. In the meantime, please keep safe at home with your families.
