

7000 BC	The first farmers settle in northern Mesopotamia, herd animals and grow crops on the fertile river soil.	The word Mesopotamia means "the land between rivers". The heart of Mesopotamia lies between the two rivers in southern Iraq. Early settlers in Mesopotamia started to gather in small villages and towns. As they learned how to irrigate land and grow crops on large farms, the towns grew bigger. Eventually these towns became large cities. New inventions such as government and writing were formed to help keep order in the cities. The first human civilization was formed.
