When? (Key Knowledge)	
1485	Henry Tudor defeats Richard III at the <u>Battle of Bosworth</u> and crowned at Westminster Abbey.
1509	Henry VII dies and is succeeded by his younger son Henry VIII. Two months after he became king, he marries Catherine of Aragon.
1533	Henry VIII marries Anne Boleyn, following divorce from Catherine of Aragon. Anne Boleyn gives birth to Elizabeth.
1536/1537	Eleven days after the execution of his second wife, Anne Boleyn, Henry VIII marries Jane Seymour. A male heir, Edward, is born to Henry VIII and Jane Seymour dies.
1547	Henry VIII dies and is succeeded by nine-year-old Edward VI.
1553	Edward VI dies and is succeeded by Lady Jane Grey. Mary I, daughter of Henry VIII and Catherine of Aragon, becomes queen.
1558	Mary dies and Elizabeth I accedes to the throne.

Background Information

The Tudors were a Welsh-English family that ruled England and Wales from 1485 to 1603. The first Tudor king was Henry VII. He became king after the battle of Bosworth field, which ended the War of the Roses. He was followed by his son, Henry VIII. His son, Edward VI ruled after him, followed by his daughters Mary I and Elizabeth I.

Henry VII	King of England from 1485 – 1509. He attained the throne when his forces defeated King Richard III at the Battle of Bosworth Field.
Henry VIII	King of England from 1509 until his death in 1547. Henry is best known for his six marriages.
Mary I	Queen of England from July 1553 until her death in 1558.
Elizabeth I	Queen of England and Ireland from 1558 until her death in 1603.
