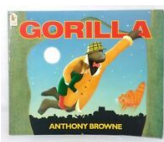
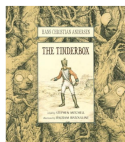


## Year 3 Autumn 1 Curriculum Newsletter

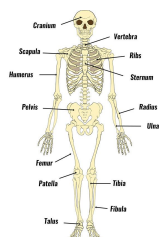
