Safe Driving and Parking

Parking and driving on Hayes Lane

For those of you with a School Street permit, or who choose to arrive earlier than the school street timings, I would like to politely remind you to drive and park considerately on Hayes Lane when dropping off and picking up your children. The white lines that are painted on the road indicate that there should be no parking there. If parents choose to park on the white lines, residents are unable to get in and out of their driveways. There have been occasions where very elderly residents have missed important medical appointments because they have been unable to get out of their driveway.

Please report any absences to the school no later than 9am. Please state your child's name, class and the reason for the absence. ***An absence MUST be reported every day until your child returns to school, even if this is a continued absence.*** This ensures we can follow our Safeguarding procedures. When you are reporting an absence for your child due to illness, please give the symptoms of the illness so that we record the illness absence correctly, and are able to identify common illnesses in a particular class or year group.
