- •Allow pupils opportunities to have a range of practical experiences in a coastal setting.
- •To discover, explore and have fun with friends.

•To enable pupils to have an enjoyable and memorable experience.



Benefits of the residential

•Educational –Year 6 children and teachers will get to know each other right at the beginning of the year so that relationships, learning and teaching can be highly effective during the children's final year before moving on to secondary school.

•Cost – the cost of an educational trip in October is significantly less than in the summer term when demand is at its highest and centres are very busy.

•Personal - Opportunity to experience being away from home, practise personal organisation and co-operation skills as well as work with others in a variety of environments.

•Development - Opportunity to have an experience which can broaden the mind and inspire future trips and educational choices.



What does the cost include?

- Coach there and back
- Rooms of 4-8 with bathrooms
- 3 meals per day
- 4 action-packed adventure activity sessions per day
- Evening activity every night

Accommodation

Rooms with bunk beds, sleep 2-6 with en suite or shared bathrooms

•All rooms are lockable and exterior doors are secure with only our staff with access.

•All teacher accommodation is on the same corridor.

•PGL staff on site all night.



Kit list

- **Packed lunch and drinks** for the first day in a day bag/rucksack.
- Towel
- Refillable water bottle
- Disco clothes
- Wash bag
- Pyjamas
- Several of long sleeved and short sleeved tops
- Several pairs of light weight (jogging bottoms, leggings).
- Several jumpers and warm layers.
- Clothes that can get dirty/wet

Safety and security

The safety and security of the trip for he children is our number one priority. Children are given a safety briefing before the trip so they know how to keep safe.

Room doors are locked with a master key that staff have and can be opened from the inside. •PGL instructors are specifically trained for their programmes.

•All gates are locked at night but can be opened from the inside in an emergency without the need for unlocking.

•Bawdsey and its activities are risk assessed every year.

•Secure perimeter fence around the site.

A PGL staff member is available on duty •Member of PGL staff on duty 24/7 hroughout the night.



Health & safety

Payment - Approximately £395.00

Payments are required to be paid by the following dates:

Deposit £50 Monday 2nd October 2023
 First Payment £70 Wednesday 6th November 2023
 Second Payment £275 (tbc) Friday 12th July 2024



- •Cancelling more than 56 days before departure = Loss of deposit and first payment.
- •Cancelling 56-29 days before departure = Loss of 60% of the total trip cost.
- •Cancelling 28-15 days before departure = Loss of 80% of the total trip cost.
- •Cancelling 14 days or fewer before departure date or afterwards = Loss of 100% of the total trip cost.
