Dear Families,

We hope that you have had a wonderful summer and we are very much looking forward to welcoming the children back to school on Monday.

As I mentioned in my newsletter at the end of the summer term, we have had a 'secure line' fence installed over the holidays. It is a 2-metre-high green fence that allows for additional safety and security on the school site and will mean that we can control exit and entry points. There are 4 large double gates to use as access points around the school site, which will be opened before school and at the end of the school day.

This half term, the blue pedestrian gate may cause a slight bottleneck, however there are plans to widen the gate over the October half term. We would therefore like to ask families to use the pedestrian path next to the vehicle entrance as much as possible for collection.

I also mentioned in the summer term newsletter that we were hoping to have new playground markings in the small playground. These works have now been moved to October half term.

Please remember that doors will now open at 8:35am and the school day starts at 8:45am.
