English

We will be reading 'Skellig' and 'Macbeth'



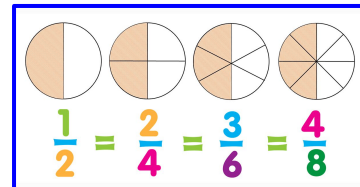
We will be learning about:

We will be learning about:

- Fractions
- Decimals

Science

Our topic is 'Electricity'.

- We will be learning about:
- Recognising circuit symbols
- Making circuits
- Setting up comparative tests
- Researching significant scientists
- Planning and carrying out fair tests

Geography

Our topic is 'Sustainability'

We will be learning about:

- Analysing data from tables and graphs
- Energy production in the UK
- Different sustainable cities
- Our community and how to make it more sustainable.

Art

Our topic is colour mixing.

We will be:

- Learning about complementary and harmonious colours
- Learning about 'Gakonga' artwork.
- Creating our own Gakonga inspired artwork

RE

We are focussing on Christianity this half term

PSHE

Our topic is Celebrating Differences.
