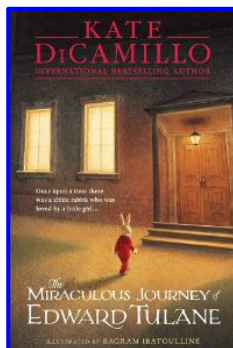


Year 4 - Spring 2 Curriculum Overview

English: This term we will be writing for different purposes based on the book *Edward Tulane*. We will

- Write a brochure.
- Write a letter.



We will also be studying:

- Fronted adverbials.
- Apostrophes for possession.

Maths:

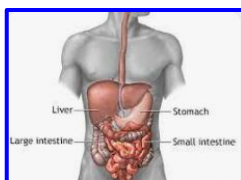
This term we will be learning about fractions:

- Calculating perimeter
- Mixed numbers.
- Equivalent fractions.
- Adding and subtracting decimals.
- Tenths and hundredths as decimals.

Science:

Our topic is 'Digestion'. We will be learning about:

- Names and types of teeth.
- The organs and processes involved in digestion.



Geography:

Our topic is rivers. We will be locating and studying the main rivers in Britain and the world. We will learn new vocabulary, such as erosion, meanders and valleys.



DT:

Our topic is making a juggling ball. We will be tie-dyeing our own fabric for decoration and learning how to stitch it together.

RE

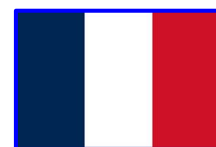
PSHE
