

Year 2 - Spring 1 Curriculum Overview

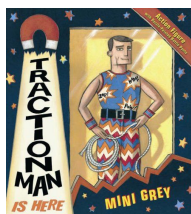
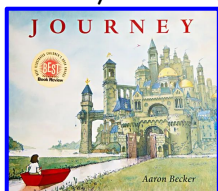

English

We will be reading 'Traction Man' and 'Journey'.

We will be learning about:

Maths

We will be learning about:

- Money, counting pounds and pence.
- Multiplication

Science

Our topic is **Materials** which is continuing from autumn 2.

We will be learning about:

- Home materials can be twisted, stretch, squashed and bent
- Waterproof and absorbent materials
- How materials suit different uses

History

Our topic is the Great Fire of London

We will be learning about:

We will be learning about:
