English Krindlekrax

Focus on:

- Direct and Indirect Speech
- Fronted adverbials
- Introduction/Conclusions
- Reporting clauses

PE

Our indoor topic is Gymnastics.

During our outside sessions we will be learning to play invasion games.

Art

Our topic is printing .

We will be learning about:

- Paul Klee
- Stencils
- Stamping
- Printing techniques

PSHE

This term the children's PSHE will be based on Dreams and Goals.

They will be learning about resilience, setbacks and self help.

Science

Our topic is Sound

We will be learning to:

- Identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating.
- Recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear.

Maths
