

Year 3 Spring 2 Curriculum Newsletter

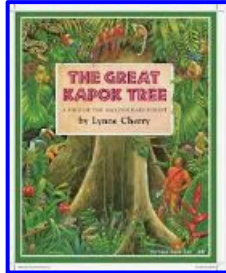

We will be learning about:

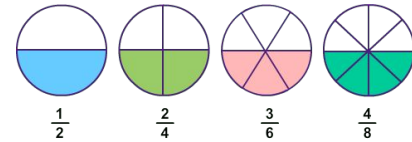
- writing a setting

- Counting in fractions

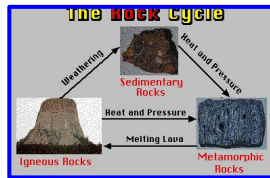


Science

- How fossils are formed

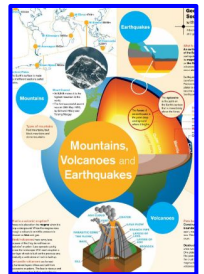


Geography
