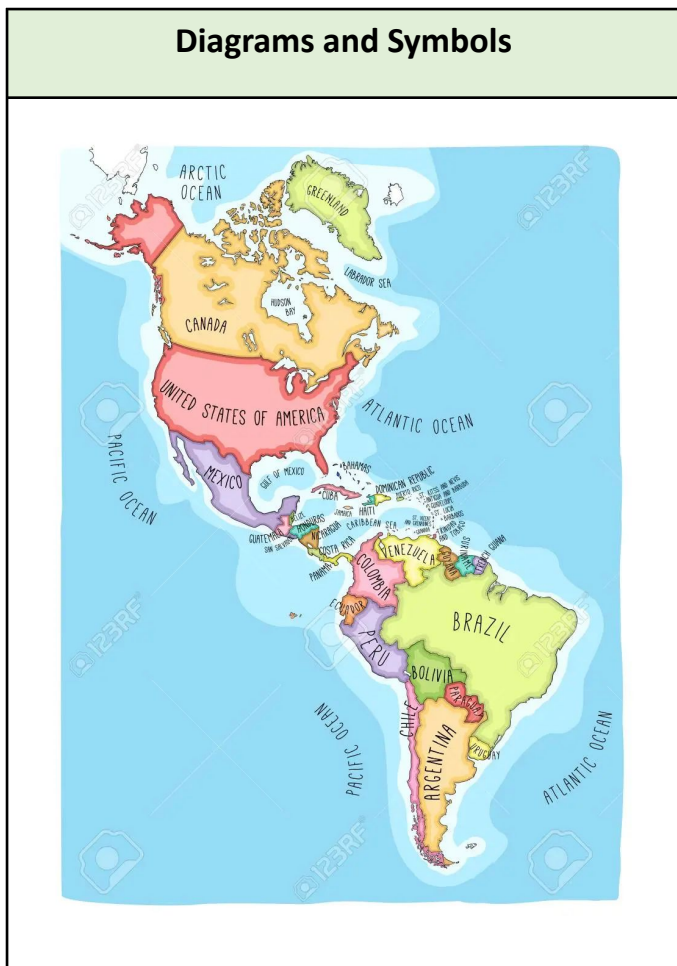

<b>Spelling</b>	<b>Definition</b>
Continent	One of the Earth's seven main divisions of land.
North America	The third largest continent located in the Northern Hemisphere.
South America	A continent located in the Southern Hemisphere.
Country	A nation with its own government, occupying a particularly territory.
Human Geography	Relates to the people who live on our planet, Earth.
Physical Geography	Relates to the natural world around us.
Map	Representation of an area of land or sea showing physical features, cities and roads.
Climate	The average weather conditions in a place 30 years or more.
Western Hemisphere	Half of the planet Earth that lies west of the Prime Meridian.
