School Uniform – Years 1 to 6

Winter Uniform (Autumn and Spring Terms)

- Navy pinafore dress, skirt, culottes or navy/dark grey tailored school trousers
- Collared white shirt (no polo shirts)
- School tie (blue and white diagonal stripes)
Elasticated for Years 1&2/ Self-Tie for years 3-6
- Navy school V-neck jumper or cardigan*
- Plain white, navy or grey socks or navy-blue tights
- Black school shoes – plain black, closed-toe shoes, low ankle boots, flat (**no trainers**)
- Any colour coat (a bright coat with reflective strips is encouraged for easy visibility)
- Wellies (any colour) – essential for outdoor learning and playtimes
- Waterproof coat to be kept in school – essential for outdoor learning and playtimes
- Winter hat

Summer Uniform (Summer term and can be worn until first Autumn half term)

- Blue and white gingham check or striped dress/playsuit
- Dark grey or navy tailored shorts or skirt
- Black school shoes – plain black, closed-toe shoes, low ankle boots, flat (**no trainers**)
- White polo shirt*
- Sunhat

PE Kit – All Terms

- Plain T-shirt of house colour (red, yellow, blue or green - children stay in the same house as they move from year to year)
- Plain shorts/tracksuit bottoms/sport leggings/skins/shorts - plain black or navy blue
- Plain sweatshirt/tracksuit top/jumper – navy blue or black (**no tops with hoods**)
- Trainers (waterproof) – white or black
- No jewellery including watches and earrings (plain studs that have been in less than 6 weeks must be covered with tape)
- PE bag* (for swimming in Year 4)

School Bags – All Terms

Due to a lack of space in our school corridors, we kindly ask that you adhere to the following:

- Years 1 and 2 - Book Bag* only (no handbags or rucksacks)
- Year 3-6 - small rucksack (no handbags or large rucksacks). Bags only need to be big enough for a pencil case, and a couple of books.

Jewellery, nail polish and hair accessories

- Children may wear a discrete, functional watch (this should be removed for PE) and **no smart watches**
- Children are permitted to wear small, plain gold/silver stud earrings (these should be removed or covered in tape for PE). No other jewellery is allowed.
- Children are not permitted to wear nail polish, nail extensions or make up.
- Children should wear small, discrete hair accessories in line with our school colours (white, black, blue or blue/white).
- Holiday braids must be hidden discreetly under hair.
- No unnatural hair colours
- These expectations also apply for 'own clothes' days

Year 6 hoodies

- Year 6 are not allowed to wear their leavers' hoodies in school.

Please ensure that all clothing is clearly labelled so that mislaid items can be returned.
