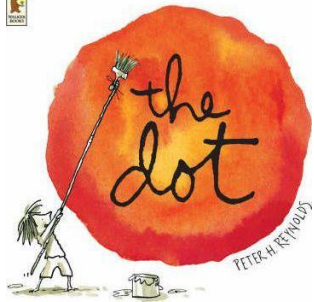
Dear Parents and Carers

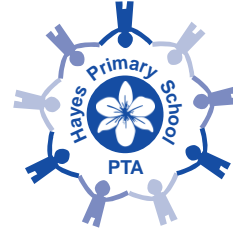

These clinics are where families, who have concerns about their pre-school child's speech, language and communication skills development, can turn up without an appointment at advertised times.

Your child will be seen by a speech and language therapist for an informal, play based assessment and advice will be given on how to help your child's development.
