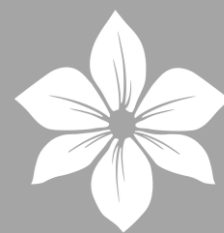

We are delighted to announce that Luca in year 3 has been selected for 8 and under Kent County Tennis Training. He trains once a month with the best 8 and under players in the county.

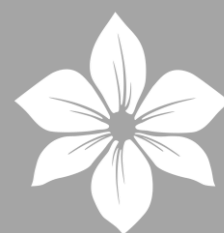


Siena Rae Mills

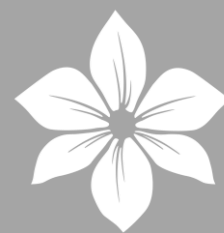
