Hayes Primary School are moving towards using a LMS (learning management system) called Google Classroom. We will be using this initially to set homework, and pupils from Years 1 to 6 will be able to log in and access the homework menu and resources for homework challenges set.

This system will also enable better communication and feedback to pupils on their learning, if we find ourselves in the unfortunate event of a second lockdown.

We feel that using Google Classroom will provide many benefits including:

- improvements in pupil's ICT skills with pupils submitting homework online;
- streamlined communication;
- clearer expectations around homework;
- increased pupil independence;
- better resources to support completion of homework such as video links and suggested websites.

We aim to have the new homework system ready for the week commencing 28th September. In the interim your child will be set a basic homework task each week. E.g. Revising some key skills from English or Maths. This will be available on the school website or will be handed out in school.

Your child's account details and access details for the homework will be sent out in due course, along with details of a remote training session so that you can fully support your child.
