### Dangerous Driving

### COVID-19 Testing

Could we please remind all parents and carers that if a member of your household develops COVID-19 symptoms and therefore needs to be tested for COVID-19, then the whole household needs to self-isolate until the test result is received. Please do not send your child to school. Should the result be negative, this result needs to be forwarded to [admin@hayes-pri.bromley.sch.uk](mailto:admin@hayes-pri.bromley.sch.uk) BEFORE your child returns to school. Should the result be positive, the household needs to isolate for 10 days from the onset of symptoms.

### Reporting Illnesses

We are then able to record the illness absence correctly, and are able to identify common illnesses in a particular class or year group. Please see and follow the COVID-19 Symptoms Protocols circulated on September 9<sup>th</sup> should your child display any of the COVID-19 symptoms. We appreciate your cooperation and support in this matter.

Any absences have to be reported to the school no later than 9am. ***An absence MUST be reported every day until your child returns to school, even if this is a continued absence.*** This ensures we can follow our Safeguarding procedures.
