Special Lunch Menu

Please be advised we are having a special lunch menu on Thursday 3rd October. Should your child normally have a packed lunch and would like to have a school dinner on this day, your child needs to advise class teacher at registration, and the meal can be paid for via parent pay. Please note that EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 have Universal Free School Meals, so payment is not required.

Lunch Options

If your child is changing their dinner option, from packed lunch to school dinners for example, this needs to be in writing to the school office. A two week notice period is required.

Parking and Driving on George Lane

Please be reminded to remain courteous towards our neighbours, and to park and drive sensibly in George Lane. During the afternoon the school car park for EYFS and KS1 does not open until 3pm. Therefore, please do not enter George Lane until the car park is open as this causes serious congestion to our neighbours trying to enter and leave their properties, and would block access for emergency vehicles. KS2 parents should only come into George Lane if it is absolutely necessary.

Medication

Many thanks for those of you that have returned medication into school. If your child requires medication in school, please bring this into the school office with the appropriate forms completed. These can be printed off of the school website or are available in the school office.

Donations of tissues

Many thanks to those parents who have donated boxes of tissues. The continued donations of tissues are really appreciated.

Hay Fever

At an allergy conference last year attended by members of the Bromley Healthcare Team, it was suggested by a Consultant in Paediatric Allergy, that children be given a long acting non-sedating antihistamine such a Cetirizine (once a day), rather than a short acting sedating antihistamine such as Piriton. Parents should speak to their GP or pharmacist for any further information and advice.

If your child does suffer from Hay Fever, could you please ensure that antihistamine medication is given to your child before coming into school in the morning. This will ensure your child is protected, will prevent symptoms from developing, and they will therefore be able to focus and concentrate in class. Your corporation is really appreciated.

Staff Car Park - Please DO NOT walk through

Please be reminded that parents and children should **NOT** walk through the staff car park at any time as this is in constant use. This is extremely dangerous so please ensure you walk on the footpaths provided. Thank you for your cooperation.

Items for the day

It is essential that pupils have all the items they need for their day, with them when they come into school in the morning. This includes water bottles, packed lunches, musical instruments, sports kits etc. It can be very unsettling for children if they do not have all of their necessary items with them, and can cause upset. Therefore, could we please ask that you ensure your children have everything they need for that day, with them when they come into school at drop off. Many thanks for your support in this matter.

Reporting Absences - Daily

Please be reminded that any absences have to be reported to the school no later than 9am. An absence MUST be reported every day until your child returns to school, even if this is a continued absence. This ensures we can follow our Safeguarding procedures.
