Parking and Driving on George Lane

Please be reminded to remain courteous towards our neighbours, and to park and drive sensibly in George Lane. During the afternoon the school car park for EYFS and KS1 does not open until 3pm. Therefore, please do not enter George Lane until the car park is open as this causes serious congestion to our neighbours trying to enter and leave their properties, and would block access for emergency vehicles. KS2 parents should only come into George Lane if it is absolutely necessary.

Staff Car Park – Please DO NOT walk through

Please be reminded that parents and children should **NOT** walk through the staff car park at any time as this is in constant use. This is extremely dangerous so please ensure you walk on the footpaths provided. Thank you for your cooperation.

Items for the day

It is essential that pupils have all the items they need for their day, with them when they come into school in the morning. This includes water bottles, packed lunches, musical instruments, sports kits etc. It can be very unsettling for children if they do not have all of their necessary items with them, and can cause upset.
