This includes water bottles, packed lunches, musical instruments, sports kits etc. It can be very unsettling for children if they do not have all of their necessary items with them, and can cause upset. If your child is changing their dinner option, from packed lunch to school dinners for example, this needs to be in writing to the school office. A two week notice period is required.

Reporting Absences - Daily

Please be reminded that any absences have to be reported to the school no later than 9am. **An absence MUST be reported every day until your child returns to school, even if this is a continued absence.** When reporting the absence, please provide full details including symptoms of illness so it can be correctly reflected in our records. This ensures we can follow our Safeguarding procedures. Many thanks for your cooperation in this matter.

Please can you ensure that your child has appropriate clothing for the weather in school each day and a **named pair of wellies** to be stored in their class welly store.
