Re: Band on the run - Autumn Term

Dear Year 3 and 4 parents,

We are very excited to be running another 'Band on the Run' project in the first half of Autumn Term. It is a five week project that allows children to begin learning an instrument. This year, we are running a joint woodwind and brass project so children will have the chance to learn the clarinet, trumpet/cornet, trombone or baritone. Within the five weeks, they learn how to play basic tunes on their instrument and have the chance to play with other children in a full band. They will also perform in a concert at the end of the project.

We are offering this opportunity to Year 3 and 4 children this term and would like to give your child the chance to be part of it at a subsidised cost of £47.50. This works out as very good value as each week they have an instrument specific group lesson, a group sectional rehearsal and a full band rehearsal. There is an expectation that children will practice frequently at home over the course of the project. They are also given an instrument to use during the project.

This would be a particularly good step for those children who were in pBuzz class last year as a transition into playing a brass instrument.

If your child would like to be part of this project, please send back the form below by Monday 9th September 2019 at the latest. **Places will be awarded on a 'first come, first served' basis.** If successful, we will then confirm your child's place and contact you about payment. There are limited spaces so please be prompt if your child would like to join in. We hope they will take this fantastic opportunity.
