Re: Visit to The British Museum

On Tuesday 28th January 2020, Year 5 will be visiting the British Museum in connection with their learning focus on Ancient Greece. This trip will allow the children to learn about the culture of Ancient Greece and look at key artefacts from this period of time. There will be no charge for this trip.

We will be travelling to the Museum by train and London Underground; the children will be accompanied by all teachers and TAs and we will require some parent helpers. Children should arrive at school promptly at the normal time of **8.40am** and the class will be leaving the school premises at **8.55am** to ensure we are on time for the activities planned at the Museum. We will be walking to Hayes Station to get the train to London Charing Cross where we will then take the London Underground to Tottenham Court Road.

We will aim return back to school for normal collection at **3:25pm** and children will be dismissed as usual from the classroom. If there is a delay in our itinerary we will inform the school office who will communicate this via the usual means of communication.

Children should wear their normal school uniform and will need to bring a **packed lunch and two bottles of water** for the day - they will not require any other items or equipment.
