Reporting Absences - Daily

Please be reminded that any absences have to be reported to the school no later than 9am. An absence MUST be reported every day until your child returns to school, even if this is a continued absence. When reporting the absence, please provide full details including symptoms of illness so it can be correctly reflected in our records. This ensures we can follow our Safeguarding procedures. Parking and Driving on George Lane

Please be reminded to remain courteous towards our neighbours, and to park and drive sensibly in George Lane. During the afternoon the school car park for EYFS and KS1 does not open until 3pm. Therefore, please do not enter George Lane until the car park is open as this causes serious congestion to our neighbours trying to enter and leave their properties, and would block access for emergency vehicles. KS2 parents should only come into George Lane if it is absolutely necessary.
