Coronavirus

Firstly, I would like to thank the whole school community for their sensible response to the current Covid-19 situation. During these unprecedented times, it is important we all support each other, taking sensible action where needed and being considerate of everyone around. The kindness and thoughtfulness we are observing from children, parents and staff is great to see and important as we all move forwards together.

We continue to monitor the situation closely and respond in a timely fashion to the daily Government advice and declarations by Public Health England. Our priority is to make decisions in the best interests of all and at the same time, continue to educate and safeguard the children in our care.

The most recent advice we have been given is:

- Any child with a fever or persistent cough should stay at home for **14 days**.
- Anyone who lives within that household should also stay at home for **14 days**.
- If a parent/carer or other adult who lives in the household is displaying a fever or persistent cough then any children who live within the household need to stay at home for **14 days**.
