Re: Home Learning

Your child will be bringing home a blank exercise book today to complete their learning in (this is to keep at home for the foreseeable future ready for any home learning that needs to be undertaken). By the end of tomorrow, children in KS1 will be bringing home 3 new reading books and children in KS2 will be bringing home 2 new QTS books.

If official school closure happens, we will be starting weekly home learning via the school website. Our teachers are preparing for this now and there will be more details on this to follow if this happens.


During this period of self-isolation for certain groups and families
