URGENT: KEY WORKER INFORMATION NEEDED

Please respond to this letter by 2pm if the following applies to you.

<u>From Monday, all children should be kept at home wherever possible</u>. However, if your work is critical to the COVID -19 response or you work in one of the critical sectors listed below (i.e keyworkers), **and** you cannot keep your child safe at home then your child/children will be prioritised for education provision.

We will be able to keep this provision open for as long we can sufficiently staff it. It is possible that this provision may have to be run from an alternative location.

Please see the full list of keyworker roles on the next page.

If you think you qualify as a 'keyworker' please email the answers to the below questions as a matter of urgency.

This is not a guarantee of childcare. We will be in contact with you later today if we are able to offer your child a place from Monday onwards.

Moving forward, we may need confirmation of your position as a keyworker from your employer.

If you do not hear from us by the end of the day today, please do not send your child/children to school from next week until further notice.
