Mrs Cook has been learning how to ride a scooter and she looks very proud of herself! You may see her scootering to school when we return!

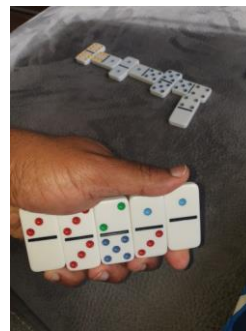
