












Dear Parents and Carers,

Re Covid-19 potential re-opening of schools

As you have seen from recent announcements, the Government is considering the phased return of certain year groups to schools from 1st June 2020: Reception, Year 1 and Year 6. Alongside this, we will continue to open our schools for vulnerable pupils and the children of keyworker staff in all year groups.

The Spring Partnership Trust are planning for the phased return of pupils, taking into account the guidance on social distancing, personal hygiene and health and safety. There are many considerations for us to undertake in order to ensure the safe return for everyone. This will take some time, so please bear with us and we will be in contact as soon as we are able to confirm our plan.
