## School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme for EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2

The School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme (SFVS) is a government programme that entitles every child in England in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2, to a piece of fruit or vegetable each day. When we returned to school before the summer holidays, the government put this scheme on hold due to the Coronavirus. We are happy to inform you that they have now reinstated the scheme. Therefore, from **Monday 28**<sup>th</sup> **September**, if you child is in EYFS, Year 1 or Year 2, please do not send your child in to school with a snack from home as they will be provided with a piece of fruit or a vegetable at playtime.
