Year 4 Residential to Hindleap Warren
Wednesday 9th-Friday 11th September 2020

We are excited to announce the location and dates for the residential trip when your child will be in Year 4. It will be at Hindleap Warren from Wednesday 9th-Friday 11th September 2020.

We would like to invite you to an introductory meeting for the trip on Tuesday 14th January at **18:00** in the large hall (entrance through the Y5/6 door).

Hindleap Warren is an outdoor adventure centre in East Sussex and offers a wide range of outdoor adventurous activities including: high rope courses, bush craft, rock climbing, obstacle courses, forest walks and team building challenges. We were extremely impressed with the activities on offer and the quality of the site and instructors on our previous trip. Children are in groups of approximately 12 children for each activity so their time on each activity is maximised. Price: Approximately £200.00 (final total to be confirmed when the number of children attending has been finalised). This includes transport to and from the centre, all food, all activities and accommodation.

To guarantee your child a place, we will require a non-refundable deposit of £56.00 payable **by Monday 3rd February 2020**. Payments can only be made by ParentPay (we are unable to accept cheques or cash). Please select: "Year 4 Hindleap Warren 9th -11th September 2020." Please contact the finance office if you require a copy of your activation letter – finance@springpartnership.co.uk. Paying the deposit on ParentPay automatically acts as permission for your child to take part in this trip.

Please note that late deposits will mean your child is not guaranteed a place.

Instalments are required to be paid by the following dates:

Please note the terms and conditions for cancellation charges:

- Cancelling more than 60 days prior to the residential = refund of trip cost but loss of deposit.
- Cancelling 60 days or less prior to residential = Loss of 100% of total cost of the trip.

Aims of the residential trip:

- To **discover, explore and have fun** with friends.
- To develop **team building, communication and resilience** skills.
- To enable pupils to have an **educational, enjoyable and memorable** experience.
- To make links to Science learning about **habitats, food chains and sustainability**.

Benefits:

- **Educational** –children and teachers will get to know each other right at the beginning of the year so that relationships, learning and teaching can be highly effective during the children's KS2 journey.
- **Cost** – the cost of an educational trip in September is significantly less for parents than in the summer term when demand is at its highest and centres are very busy.
- **Personal** - Opportunity to experience being away from home, practise personal organisation and co-operation skills as well as work with others in a variety of environments.
- **Development** - Opportunity to have an experience which can broaden the mind and inspire future trips and educational choices.
