Re: Update from Mr Vitarana

COVID-19 symptoms

As we continue to work to limit the transmission of COVID-19 at school, I would like to remind all parents and carers that if a member of your household develops COVID-19 symptoms and therefore needs to be tested for COVID-19, then the whole household needs to self-isolate until the test result is received. Please do not send your child to school. Should the result be negative, this result needs to be forwarded to admin@hayes-pri.bromley.sch.uk BEFORE your child returns to school. Should the result be positive, the person being tested needs to isolate for 10 days from the onset of symptoms, and the rest of the household needs to isolate for 14 days.

Christmas parties – Monday 21st December

We are asking for a voluntary donation of £1 per child to be paid via ParentPay to buy some party food for each class to have at their Christmas party. Teachers will buy individually wrapped food and quarantine them in school ready for 21st. This has been set up on ParentPay under Christmas Parties. Please pay by 14th December.

Party day will be an own clothes day for the children.

Secret Santa class Christmas cards – Deadline Tuesday 15th December

The PTA has helped organise an eco-friendly and COVID safe approach to sending Christmas cards this year. It will work by each child having one child to write a card for in their class. They will bring it in to school by the deadline above so it can be quarantined and they will then be given out. Children are not permitted to bring their own sets of Christmas cards from home to give out in school this year.

Your child will come home with who they are writing/making a card for either today or early next week.

Please return the card you are writing to your child's class teacher by the deadline above.
