This is an overview of the learning that will be taking place in EYFS this half term. Our topic this term is "Come with us to..."

English

We will be reading:

- Knuffle Bunny
- The Naughty Bus
- Where the Wild Things Are
- Room on the Broom
- Meerkat Mail

We will be learning about:

- Instruction writing for Road safety.
- To make predictions about texts.
- Designing and describing our
- own flying vehicles.
- Creating story maps.
- To use adjectives to describe.



Understand the World

Our topic is "Come with us to…" We will be learning about:

- Know some similarities and differences between the natural world around them and contrasting environments, whilst on a local trip.
- Understand some important processes and changes in the natural world around them, including the seasons and changing during planting activities.
- Children to identify similarities and differences between England and other countries / cities including New York, South Africa, Antarctica.
- Describe their immediate environment using knowledge from observation, discussion, stories, non-fiction texts and maps and local trips.

PSHE

Our topic is "Changing Me" We will be learning about:

- Naming parts of the body. Identifying some healthy foods and activities.
- Understanding and respecting the changes in themselves.
- Expressing feeling about moving to Year 1.Knowing who to ask for help if they are
- worried about change.
- Sharing memories of the best bits of this year in Reception.

ΡE

We will be developing skills in: Athletics, Fundamental Movements and Tennis.

Maths

We will be learning about: Building Numbers Beyond 10

- To build and identify numbers to 20 (and beyond) using a range of resources.
- To see that larger numbers are composed of full 10s and part of the next 10.
- Counting Patterns Beyond 10
- To count on and back beyond 10.
- To count on or back from different starting points, to say what comes before or after a given number and to place sequences of numbers in order.
- To find larger numbers on number tracks and 100 squares.

Spatial Reasoning

- To select and rotate shapes.
- To explain why they chose a particular shape and why a different shape wouldn't fit.
- To use positional language to describe where the shapes are in relation to one another.

Adding and subtraction

- to add or subtract amounts using objects, marks or number tracks.
- to recall addition calculations to 10.
- Number Patterns
- To double quantities to 10.
- To identify if a number/amount is odd or even.

Expressive Arts and Design

Our topic is "Come with us to…" We will be learning about:

- Use a variety of construction materials to design and construct vehicles focusing on safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function.
- Share their creations, explaining the process they have used whilst demonstrating how their vehicle works.
- Perform songs, rhymes, poems and stories with others, and (when appropriate) try to move in time with music.
