We will be reading 'Outlaw'



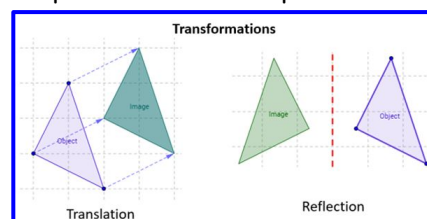
We will be learning about:
