RE EYFS Graduation

We are writing to inform you of our updated plans for the EYFS Graduation on Monday 19th July.

Due to the easing of restrictions that come into effect as of Monday 19th July, we are pleased to be able to share our class graduation ceremonies with you. Parents and carers are invited to attend but we are requesting that only **one adult** per child attends in order to keep our audience to a minimum.

You must not attend if you have any COVID symptoms or if any member of your household has COVID symptoms.

The graduation will take place on the field, opposite the EYFS outdoor area. The timings of each class graduation are as follows:

9.15am - Flamingo Class

9.45am - Puffin Class

10.15am - Robin Class

The parent car park **will not be open** onsite during any the graduation due to the playground being used by the rest of the school for their outdoor learning and playtimes.

Entering and leaving the school site

Please use the silver pedestrian gate to enter and exit the site for this event only. The one-way system is still in place at all other times.

Keeping a safe distance

Parents and carers must stay behind the taped off area at all times. Please ensure that you leave the school site as soon as the event has finished in order to allow the next group of parents to arrive. The children and teachers will not be leaving the taped off area until parents and carers have left.

If the weather is too wet on the day and we are unable to run this event, we will inform you of the cancellation via Parent Pay and on the school website. These events cannot be rescheduled as they are in the last week of term.
