












Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Year 6 final day of school (and a thank you)

Firstly, we wanted to say a huge thank you for the time, effort and money that you put into the costumes for the production. The children look amazing and it's really added an extra level to the play. We are very much looking forward to sharing the children's hard work with you in a couple of weeks.

Secondly, we have now been able to confirm details for the children's last day at school (Friday 23rd July). Please see the details below:

- Children will arrive at school at the normal time in their school uniform.
- We will have an opportunity for the children to sign shirts during the morning. They will not be able to sign the shirt/top they are wearing so they must bring in an additional shirt for this activity. They can also bring some coloured pens to school for this.
- The ice-cream van will arrive at school around 9:30am and the children will be bought an ice-cream by the PTA.
- Parents/carers can arrive from 10:50am for the leavers' assembly which will begin at approximately 11am. This will be held outside on the field. Please arrive through the pedestrian gate (despite this not following the drop-off one-way system) and walk through to where you can see the stage.
- We will have zones for each class's parents/carers. Please ensure you stay within the zone for your child's class and social distance within the zone (stay 2m away from other parents where possible). We request that just one adult per child comes to this event. We realise this is after the restrictions have lifted but we are also trying to be as cautious as possible not to put children, parents and teachers at risk of contracting COVID-19 or having to self-isolate over the Summer Holiday due to being a close contact of someone who tests positive. We hope you understand this precaution.
- After the assembly has finished, parents/carers should walk over to the field area by the pedestrian gate. The children will come inside to collect their belongings and we will then walk them over to this area to meet parents/carers at around 11:45am. Children can then say their final goodbyes to their friends and teachers.
- Please ensure you are off the school site by 12pm as this is when lunchtime starts for the rest of the school.

Thank you in advance for your understanding and support. We are very much looking forward to sharing the children's final day at Hayes Primary School with you.
