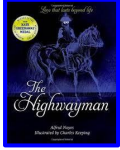


Year 5 Autumn 1 Curriculum Newsletter

We will be thinking about this key question - how do you show commitment?

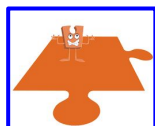


PSHE
