The term 'e-Scooter' is short for 'electric scooter'.



It is against the law to ride an e-Scooter in Bromley on the road and the pavement or in cycle lanes and parks.

Police can give the rider a £300 fine and take away the e-Scooter!



The only place it is legal to ride an e-Scooter is on private property with the landowner's permission.



It can be very dangerous to ride an e-Scooter.

There have been bad crashes around the UK and here in Bromley. Most people who fall off suffer severe head injuries, and some die.



It can be very difficult for drivers to see e-Scooters, especially at night and when riders wear dark clothing.




Some e-Scooters can go faster than push scooters or bicycles.
