#### The Phonics Session

- At Hayes Primary we follow the RWI programme.
- We teach phonics at the start of every day in differentiated groups.
- Children are re-assessed every 6 weeks.
- EYFS children are taught phonics at the start of their school day.
- Sessions last for 40 minutes.




#### English alphabetic code

One of the most complex alphabetic codes in the world.







- say the sound
- read the sound
- write the sound (handwriting rhymes- lower case)

They will also practice reading and writing previously taught sounds.

Depending on the stage of reading, children will either

make words on magnetic boards.

#### OR

- read green words and short storybooks.
- spell words.




#### Green words and Red words

Children can read Green words using their sounds.

"Special friends, read the word, Fred talk"





Red Words are also known as common exception or tricky words. They occur in stories regularly (said, what, where) but have unusual letter combinations ('ai' in the word 'said' makes the sound 'e').

Remind your child not to use Fred Talk to read Red Words but instead to 'stop and think'.

Tell them the word if you need to.



#### Reading in phonics

Once children can recognise sounds and orally blend simple words, we give them books to read in their phonics session.

We give children books with the letters that they can read which allows them to build in confidence.




#### What can I do?

- 1. Use pure sounds, not letter names.
- 2. Rapid recall of sound cards
- 3. Watch the sound lessons uploaded on Google Classroom.
- 4. Build words for children to read with sound cards.
- **5.** Use Fred Talk
- **6.** Practice handwriting using the rhymes.
- 7. Listen to your child read their blending book, paper ditty or storybook every day
- **8.** Read stories to your child every day
- 9. Keep books in the book bag every day.




#### Read Write Inc. Phonics – information for parents
