Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Current guidance re COVID-19

As we move in to the last few days of term, I would like to remind parents and carers about the current Government guidance regarding close contact testing.

If a member of your household or a close contact of yours tests positive for COVID-19, the following guidance is in place and the key message is as follows:

Anyone aged 5 years and over who lives in the same household as someone with COVID-19 or who has been a close contact elsewhere and who is not legally required to self-isolate is now strongly advised to take an LFD test every day for 7 days. If any of these LFD tests are positive, they should self-isolate in order to protect other people. The public health advice for people with symptoms of, or a positive test result for COVID-19 remains the same for everyone; they must isolate immediately for the required time given by NHS test and trace.
