You will also be able to go and visit their new classroom. No appointment is required; you can come in at any time between 15:30 and 18:00.

## Reporting Illnesses - Details of symptoms must be given.

Could we please kindly ask that, when you are reporting an absence for your child due to illness, *the full symptoms* of the illness are provided. We are then able to record the illness absence correctly, and are able to identify common illnesses in a particular class or year group.

Any absences have to be reported to the school no later than 9am, please state your child's name and class. An absence MUST be reported every day until your child returns to school, even if this is a continued absence. This ensures we can follow our Safeguarding procedures.

We would like to encourage KS1 parents and children to use the vehicle gate entrance to ease congestion on the pedestrian gate at drop and pick up times.

Please can we remind parents to drive carefully and park considerately when dropping and collecting their children at the beginning and end of the school day.

# Bikeability Cycle Training Course - Year 6

The Cycling Team has provisionally booked Bikeability Cycle Training for some of the Year 6 students at your child's school in June. Places are allocated on a first come first serve basis.

### Equipment required

Please note your child must have access to a fully roadworthy bike of the correct size for your child and a cycle helmet and they must be already able to ride in order to take part in the course. The children are to wear suitable clothes for riding in.

## What is Bikeability?

Bikeability courses are designed to train children to cycle on the road safely and with confidence, so that they can go on to make independent on-road journeys. Bikeability consist of two levels and takes places over a day and a half.

- <u>Level One registration to break</u> This is an off road assessment where the pupils will practise basic skills such as use of gears, stopping quickly with control, manoeuvring safely to avoid objects, looking all around including behind without wobbling and signalling with control. Children must complete level one in order to progress onto level two.
- <u>Level Two</u> break to end of day one. Day two registration to lunchtime This takes place on quiet local roads at locations that have been risk assessed. Children are able to use the above skills via a range of practical exercises and assessments.

All children receive a booklet, badge, and certificate for the highest level they participated in, and will receive feedback as to whether they have achieved the full award for that level. Our instructors will confirm that feedback on the back of the certificate.
